Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Accounting Standard Online Course

1. Introduction

This module provides an introduction to the Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Accounting and Reporting Standard online learning, including the importance of Scope 3 emissions within the GHG Protocol framework.

2. Key Concepts from Corporate GHG Accounting

This module provides an overview of the basic Corporate GHG accounting following the GHG Protocol.

3. Identifying Scope 3 Emissions

This module explains why climate change is an important business issue; explains the difference between scope 1, 2 and 3 emissions; and identifies the value of the scope 3 GHG accounting.

4. Setting the Boundary

This module discusses how organizations can use value chain maps to identify material Scope 3 GHG emissions and justify exclusion of non-material categories.

5. Collecting Data and Assessing Data Quality

This module describes how organizations can screen their value chains to identify material Scope 3 categories, gather primary or secondary data to calculate emissions, and fill any data gaps.

6. Calculation Guidance

This module discusses how to calculate Scope 3 emissions across the 15 categories.

7. Performing Allocation

This module discusses how to allocate emissions from within the value chain to the organization.

8. Setting Reduction Targets and Tracking Emissions

This module discusses how to set a target for reducing value chain emissions and how to track such emissions over time.

9. Performing Assurance

This module discusses the benefits and practices of third party assurance for Scope 3 GHG inventories.

10. Reporting Inventory Results

This module covers how to report your organization's Scope 3 GHG inventory to external audiences.

11. Review

This module reviews the most important aspects of the Scope 3 process and provides practical tips to get started.
