1. Welcome and goals of meeting

Summary of discussion

- The Secretariat reviewed the goals of the meeting, which include welcoming new members, an ISO update, and a post-public consultation update.
- The Secretariat welcomed new TWG members, and supporting staff from ISO.

2. ISO update

Summary of discussion

- The Secretariat provided an overview of the ISO-GHGP partnership.
- The Secretariat described the three collaboration modes of the partnership, which includes corporate standard updates through mode 1, of which the scope 2 update is a component.
- The Secretariat reviewed the governance process across ISO and GHGP, and where coordination will take place between the two entities.
- The Secretariat reviewed the ISO member selection process, and the role of ISO experts in the TWG. ISO experts serving on the TWG will represent the official position of ISO if one exists, otherwise they may act in their individual capacity.
- TWG members asked for clarification on any changes to the day-to-day operation of the working group. The Secretariat responded that the TWG will continue to operate similarly, however there will be more coordination and collaboration with ISO generally, and ISO inputs into the TWG deliberations.
- TWG members asked whether the ISO partnership will impact the overall timeline of revisions. The Secretariat responded that extensions to the timelines are necessary for the partnership and will provide more details as soon as possible.

3. Public consultation update

Summary of discussion

- The Secretariat provided an update on the public consultation, noting that approximately 1,400 responses were received. All public consultation materials will be posted on the public consultation

landing page once submissions have been processed and a high-level summary of the feedback is complete. TWG members discussed the evaluation process and next steps, including considerations around timeline and stakeholder communication.

- The Secretariat announced that the in-person workshop will take place this year, but likely not until the fall.
- An update on the Scope 2 and AMI interaction was provided, including that TWG members who expressed interest in moving from scope 2 to AMI will be notified soon.
