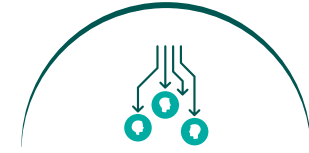
Context

ISO and GHG Protocol **join forces to meet global demand** for consistent and comparable GHG accounting



Objectives

- **Deliver co-branded standards** for GHG measurement and reporting
- **Establish a common global language** for GHG accounting
- **Reduce fragmentation**, simplify compliance, and support decarbonization

- **Product**

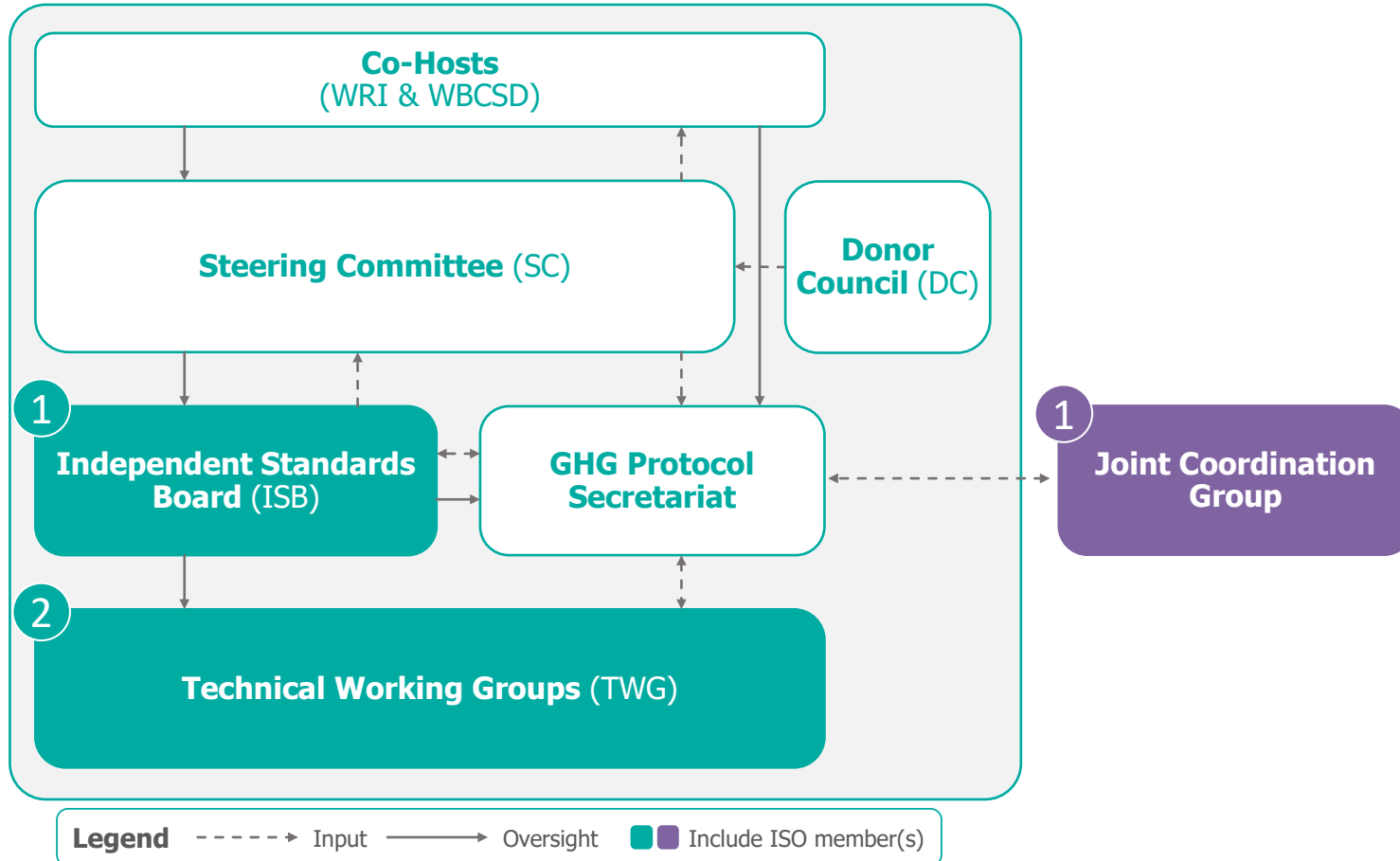

ISO will be integrated into **two** GHGP governance bodies and **one** transitional coordination body

GHG Protocol governance structure reflecting ISO integration for overview purposes



- 1 Independent Standard Board**
 - ISO will join as an Observing Entity (non-voting status)
- 2 Technical Working Groups**
 - **Experts** from ISO WG4 (14064-1) to join each GHGP TWG and actively engage in standard development process
 - **Supporting experts** to assist primary experts with reviewing and drafting materials.
- 1 Joint Coordination Group**
 - GHGP Secretariat and ISO counterparts will meet to **facilitate coordination across standards** by identifying potential areas of misalignment and raising them to appropriate governance bodies

ISO-GHGP Partnership advancing with new ISO members joining our TWG

1. ISB approved the ISO-nominated experts

2. ISO experts will be formally integrated into the TWGs starting 2026

Experts to join the TWG meetings; Supporting experts to contribute in their supporting role

ISO expert selection process

1. ISO requested its **National Standard Bodies to nominate experts** from current ISO TC 207 / SC 7 / WG4 (14064-1)
2. ISO reviewed nominated experts and **evaluated them against several criteria points**, including:
 1. Expertise and practical experience of relevant ISO and GHGP standards
 2. Historical participation and contribution of member in past meetings and work
 3. Demographic information to ensure balanced representation in terms of gender, sector, professional background and geography
3. Selected members **approved them via ISO TC 207 / SC 7*** following an **internal committee ballot**
4. Final **review and approval of changes to TWG composition by GHGP ISB**



- **GHGP Secretariat shared demographic information of the current TWGs** – incl. gender identity, geography, and sectoral rep – to ensure alignment with the ToR and maintain balanced expertise and perspectives
- **ISO made every effort to incorporate these considerations** and promote diversity and balance across the groups, to the extent possible

1. GHG Protocol received ~1,400 responses across both consultations. We are evaluating this feedback and will share summaries and the full set of responses in the coming months.
