Description of complaint or concern.:

I am writing to request that the Secretariat issue meeting minutes for the ISB meetings. The ISB has made some decisions recently where meeting minutes would be very helpful in understanding the discussions and decisions that were made about the Scope 2 Market-Based method and consequential accounting for the electricity sector. Section 5.5 of the ISB Terms of Reference indicates that meeting minutes should be publicly available. Specifically, Section 5.5.3 states “Sensitive information may be redacted from the publicly available minutes on a case-by-case basis, in consultation with the Chair” which indicates that meeting minutes will be issued publicly. Furthermore, Section 5.5.9 states “Meeting summaries capturing attendance, key deliberations, outcomes and decisions will be made publicly available on the GHG Protocol website” which further demonstrates that the meeting minutes will be available publicly on the GHGP website. In the service of transparency and effective decision making, and as required by the ISB Terms of Reference, the Secretariat needs to issue meeting minutes for all ISB meetings. Furthermore, Section 5.5.4 also indicates that all decisions should be accompanied by a basis for conclusion, stating “Decisions will be accompanied by a basis for conclusions, which will note any objections by members.” A basis for conclusion was not issued for the recent decisions about the Scope 2 and Consequential Consultation. Please issue a basis for conclusions for these recent decisions.
